Welcome, Referees, to the 2009/2010 Indoor Season!

CMSA will be continuing the Field Marshall Program into the Indoor 2009/2010 Season and we again ask for your assistance in it running successfully.

WHAT IS IT?

Each team will be **required** to provide a parent (or other adult spectator) to be the 'Field Marshall (FM)'. All teams are provided with neon orange arm bands which **must** be worn by the individual. The FM is expected to remind the parents from their team that negative comments directed to the official will not be tolerated. **The referee still has all their powers from Law 5 to dismiss a parent/spectator. The referee can dismiss the FM like any other spectator. It is not the FM's responsibility to eject a spectator, therefore do not ask the FM to do so.**

WHAT DO YOU, AS A REFEREE, NEED TO DO?

On the game sheets for 2009/2010, there is a line for "Field Marshall". The individual acting as the FM must have their name indicated on the game sheet. Teams will be subject to fines if they do not.

WHICH TEAMS ARE EXEMPT?

No teams are exempt from the Field Marshall Program for the 2009/2010 Indoor Season.
